



Abortion Pill Talk MEMBER AGREEMENT

This agreement is for an organization to join Abortion Pill Talk (APT).

This agreement is between the PREGNANCY HELP ORGANIZATION and Pro Life Ribbon.

Price:

\$400 per month for those who agree to join APT in 2025

Backstory on Price:

The price will go up on January 1st each year (historically near 2.5%) based on the COLA (Cost of Living Adjustment) to cover inflation.

For Religious PHOs Only:

By signing the linked agreement – you agree that your organization's leadership agree with the following statement: JESUS IS GOD COME IN THE FLESH and/or they agree with the Apostle's Creed.

Backstory on Pro Life Ribbon and iRapture.com:

Pro Life Ribbon is a shell organization (like a turtle shell) that allows us to have religious freedom and be under the protection of the prolife TX AG (Texas Attorney General). iRapture.com is a working vendor – managing the work and coordinating with partners on this project (Connie Ambrecht and Infinite Worth).

Backstory on Abortion Pill Talk:

APT is a national collaborative multi-clinic advertising campaign designed to reach someone with helpful information who is researching the abortion pill.

Defining Terms:

Body of Law: we place ourselves and this work under the state defined in our Body of Law clause. The address of Pro Life Ribbon is in Texas. Our Body of Law is under Texas. This national campaign is being run from under the law of the state of Texas.

Body of Law

This national advertising campaign will take place under the BODY OF LAW under the state of Texas.

Agreement Length:

The agreement length is month to month. You may cancel/stop at anytime with just 30 days notice.
